

Permission criteria in Article 5, Paragraph 17 of the Kandatsu Snow Resort ski Area Terms and Conditions

Kandatsu Resort Co., Ltd. has established the following permission standards for the prohibited activities set out in Article 5, Paragraph 17 of the Kandatsu Snow Resort Ski Resort Terms and Conditions (Ordinance No. 5 of August 31, 2022).

(definition)

Article 1 In this permission criteria, the meanings of the terms listed in the following items shall be as specified in each item.

- ① Ski School: Refers to an organization, company, or individual that provides skiing and snowboarding instruction as a business.
- ② Times: Refers to the number of times a ski school is opened, including consecutive days.
- ③ Day: Refers to the day the ski school was opened, regardless of whether the ski school was opened all day long.
- ④ Long-term ski school: Refers to operating a ski school for a total of fifteen days or more per month.
- ⑤ Short-term ski school: Refers to operating a ski school for a total of ten days or more per month.

(Official ski school)

Article 2 Long-term ski schools must be accredited by the All Japan Ski Association (hereinafter referred to as “SAJ”) or the Professional Ski Instructors Association of Japan (hereinafter referred to as “SIA”).

(Long-term ski school teacher qualification)

Article 3 A teacher who instructs as long-term ski school must have one of the following qualifications.

- ① Certified ski instructors and associate instructors, certified snowboard instructors and associate instructors, certified cross-country ski instructors, and certified instructors certified by each member organization, as specified by SAJ in the “Standards for Establishment of Certified Ski Schools, etc. and Application and Implementation Guidelines(520)”.
- ② Alpine skiing stages I, II, III, IV, snowboarding stages I, II, III, IV, and telemark skiing stages I, II, III, IV, as defined by SIA in the “SIA Certified Snow Sports Teacher Certification Regulations”.
- ③ SIA has decided on “Matters stipulating the activities listed in the lower column of Table 5 of Appended Table 1 of the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act based on the provisions of Article 7, Paragraph 1, Item 2 of the same Act, Appended Table 12-A.” Qualifications related to ski instruction that are recognized to be equivalent to or higher than those listed above.
- ④ Based on the ski instruction, “Table 2 of Appended Table 1 of the Act, stipulated in the Ministerial Ordinance establishing the standards of Article 7, Paragraph 1, Item 2 of the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act (Ministry of Justice Ordinance No.16 of 1990) Activities listed in the bottom column of the skills section, status of residence of Standard No.8.

(Short-term ski school teacher qualification)

Article 4 Teachers instructing at short-term ski schools must hold the qualifications set forth in the preceding article, or persons with certifiable overseas qualifications, or persons who have competed in skiing or snowboarding competitions at the Winter Olympics or World Championships.

Short-term ski school instructors are limited to those who have purchased our season pass or a local lift ticket.

(Working qualification)

Article 5 Foreign nationals who teach at long-term ski schools or short-term ski schools must have employment qualifications based on the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act.

(Liability insurance)

Article 6 Long-term ski schools or short-term ski schools must have liability insurance for damages of 300 million yen or more (both personal and property) per accident.

(Application for permission for long-term ski school)

Article 7 A person who intends to operate a long-term ski school must apply for permission in writing to Kandatsu Resort Co., Ltd., attaching documents proving the requirements listed in Articles 2 to 6.

Payment of consideration to the ski resort will be specified in a separate contract for business outsourcing, and both parties will enter into a contract.

(Application for permission for short-term ski school)

Article 8 A person who intends to open a short-term ski school must apply for permission to open a short-term ski school by attaching the following documents to the application form (Form 1).

- ① A list containing the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of the representative and the supervising teacher.
- ② Copy of document proving the qualifications of the instructor
- ③ For foreigners, a copy of a document proving work qualification
- ④ Copy of proof of liability insurance
- ⑤ Photo of the uniform to be used if there is one
- ⑥ Fill out and submit the Business Activity Permit Application Form (Form 2) for each day of use.  
※It also contains information about paying the ski resort.

(Prohibited matter)

Article 9 No long-term ski school or short-term ski school may be established without permission from Kandatsu Resort Co., Ltd.

2 If the provisions of the preceding paragraph are violated, the operating permit will be revoked.

(Requirements to be observed)

- ① Understand the Kandatsu Snow Resort Safety Ordinance and the Kandatsu Snow Resort Ski Area Terms and Conditions.
- ② Follow the instruction of Kandatsu Resort Co., Ltd. And cooperate in the safe and secure operation of the ski resort.
- ③ Always strive to improve your skills and guidance and improve the quality of your services.
